Hallie Preskill, Ph.D., is a Professor in the School of Behavioral and Organizational Sciences at Claremont Graduate University, where she teaches graduate courses in program evaluation, organizational learning, Appreciative Inquiry, and training and design and delivery.

Her books include *Reframing Evaluation Through Appreciative Inquiry* (Preskill & Catsambas, 2006), *Building Evaluation Capacity: 72 Activities for Teaching and Training* (Preskill & Russ-Eft, 2005), *Evaluation in Organizations: A Systematic Approach to Enhancing Learning, Performance & Change* (Russ-Eft & Preskill, 2001), *Evaluative Inquiry for Learning in Organizations* (Preskill & Torres, 1999), *Evaluation Strategies for Communication and Reporting* (Torres, Preskill & Piontek, 2nd ed., 2005), *Using Appreciative Inquiry in Evaluation* (Preskill & Coghlan, *New Directions for Evaluation* #100, 2003).

She received the American Evaluation Association's Alva and Gunnar Myrdal Award for Outstanding Professional Practice in 2002, and the University of Illinois Distinguished Alumni Award in 2004.
